Job Responsibilities:

Typical responsibilities, other responsibilities may be added when deemed appropriate:

- Coordinate musical and choral arrangements with Pastor's sermon.
- Attend monthly Unified Church Board Meetings and present a report that should include joys, concerns, needs and any other information helpful to the board in order to support this ministry;
- Conduct rehearsals as necessary to prepare for services and other programs at our church;
- Identify and attract new members for Choir, Praise Team and Bell Choir;
- Work collaboratively with Bell Choir Director and Organist to provide an engaging worship experience for our church;
- Work collaboratively with Director of Education in support of youth participation in musical programs, such as the Christmas Musical or other activities;
- Additional support as needed by the Senior Pastor;

- Degree in Music, Music Education or similar qualification;
- Experience in Choral and Music direction;
- Flexible schedule;
- Possess a collaborative mindset and strong work ethic;
