

Job Description: Organist

Reports to:

- Choir and Music Director, Senior Pastor

Guiding principles:

- To Love Praise and Glorify God;
- Be an example of our principles: Humility, Grace, Prayer, Love, Compassion and Service.

Job Responsibilities:

Typical responsibilities, other responsibilities may be added when deemed appropriate:

- Provide musical accompaniment all worship services (Sundays and non-Sunday services):
 - Weekly Hymns (Chosen by the Pastor).
 - Weekly Prelude (Played just before beginning of service).
 - Weekly Postlude (Played after the concluding hymn of service).
 - Prelude/Postlude are chosen by the organist.
 - Offertory: Only when choral anthems are not offered
- Support Children's programming by providing accompaniment, when necessary, in musical programs.
- Provide musical accompaniment for Choral rehearsals:
 - 7-8pm
- Have access and availability to provide a substitute organist when needed in coordination with the Choir and Music Director.
- Additional support as needed by the Choir and Music Director;

Minimum qualifications:

- Playing Demonstration Required
 - Please prepare one organ selection
 - Please play one hymn (Chosen by the pastor)
- Bachelor's Degree Preferred
 - Music Performance – Piano/Organ
 - B.A. Music – Piano/Organ Primary
 - Music Education – Piano/Organ Primary
- Organ Experience 2 Years
 - While preferred, not required.
- A love of music, God and ability to inspire congregation with this ministry.

Compensation and benefits:

- Part-Time position
- Salary and benefits at the discretion of the Senior Pastor and Unified Church Board, \$8500-\$10000
